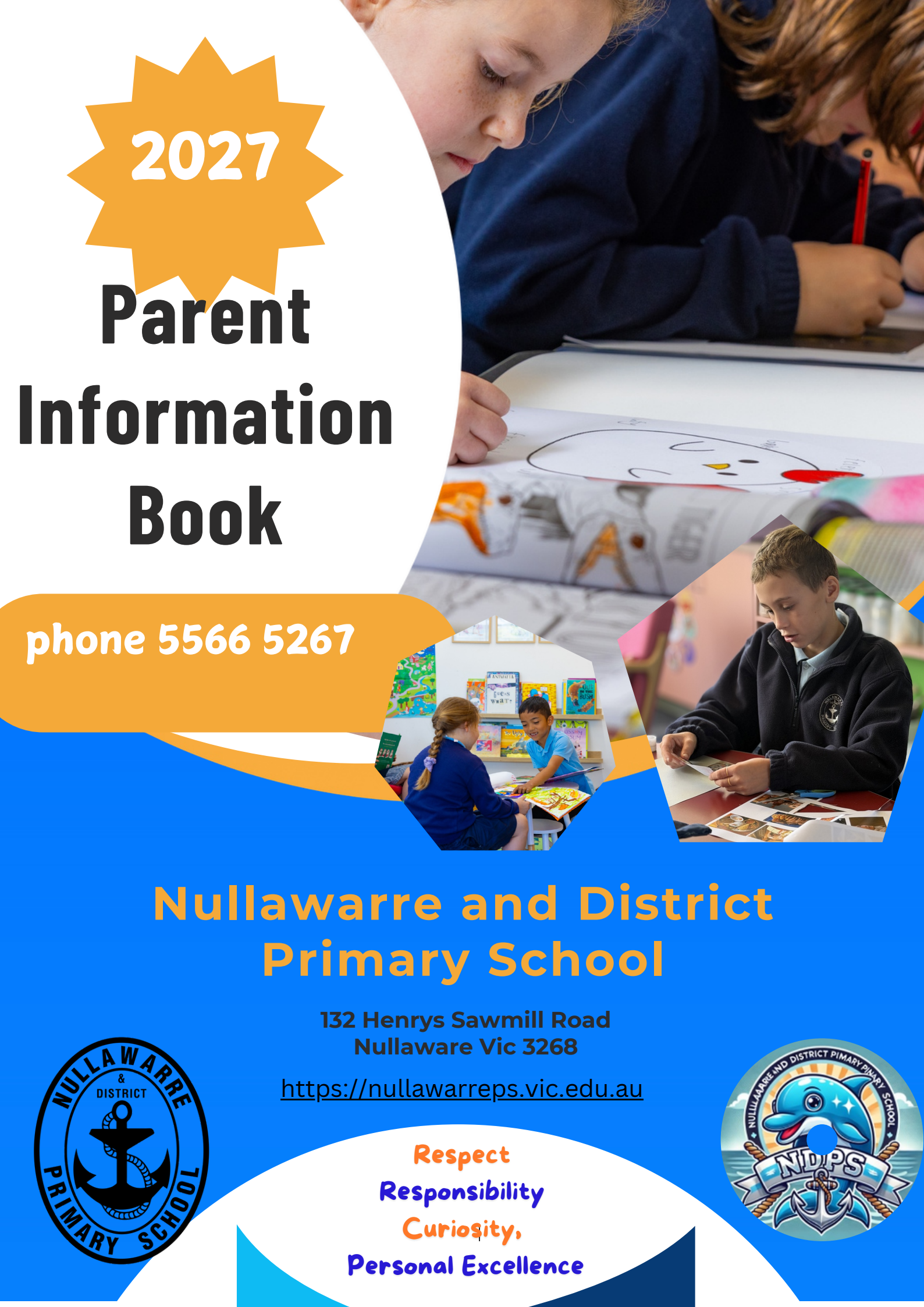

- Community celebrations (Harmony Day, Book Week, etc.)



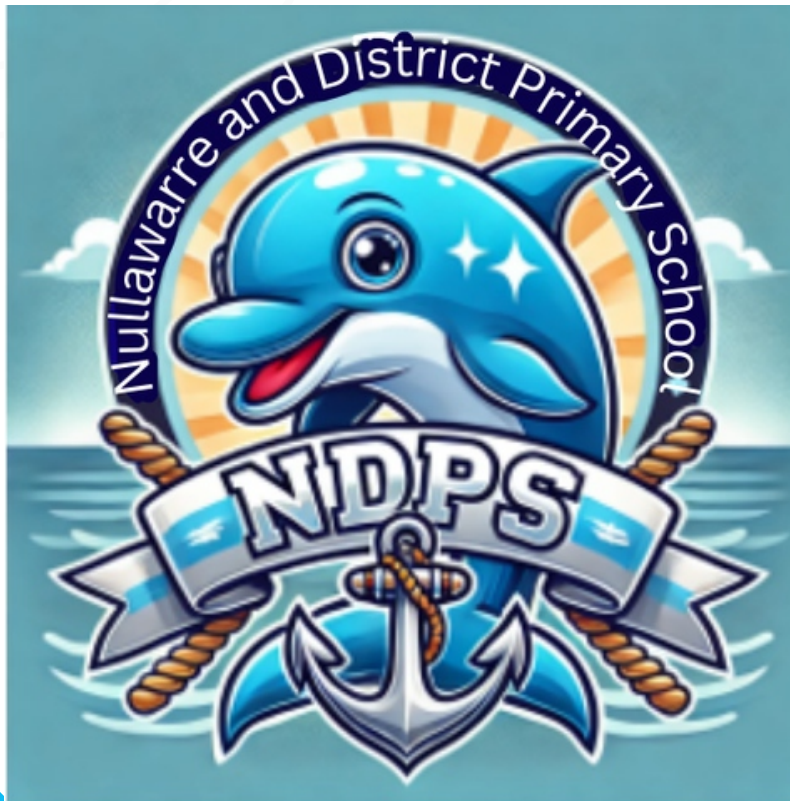

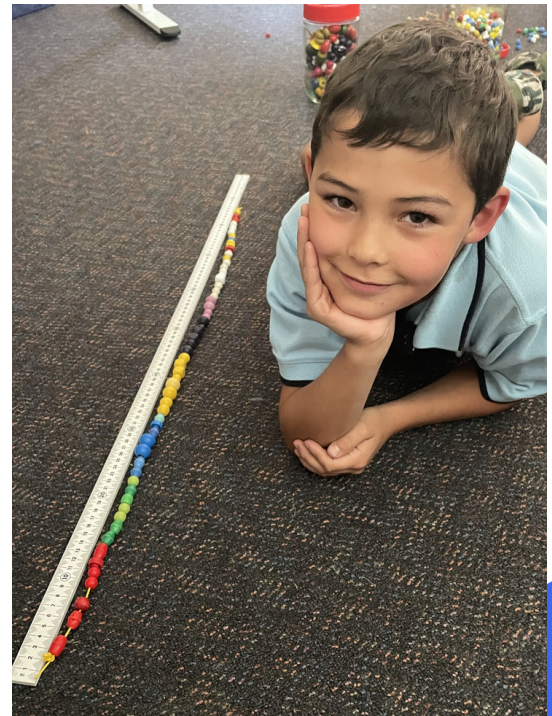
